- All poetry must be submitted before **Monday, January 21, 2019 @ 3:00 PM (MST)** to be considered for the contest.
- This is an **ALL AGES** contest.
- **ALL POETRY** must be submitted as a **MICROSOFT WORD DOCUMENT (.docx)** or **PDF via email**

- Submissions must be **CLEARLY LABELED** with the registrants **First Name, Last Name, City, and Age**. Your poem will be labeled with these items if you win the contest unless otherwise requested.
- Poems can be **NO LONGER THAN 20 LINES**.
- **UP TO THREE (3) POEM SUBMISSIONS** accepted per registrant; **ONLY ONE (1)** will be chosen.
- **ALL** forms of poetry are allowed (limerick, haiku, narrative, couplet, free verse, etc.).
- Poems containing profanity will be **DISQUALIFIED**.
